## **Regular Board Meeting**

- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 18:36.
- II. New Business and Open Items -

A. Approve Minutes from the July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Regular Board Meeting. Approved Unanimously.

- B. Audit David Green with Green and Associates Presented the Audit Report for Years Ended December 31, 2018 and 2017. The board reviewed. (Resolution 2019-7-1) was approved Unanimously.
- C. Sewer Project Update Bids were opened June27th. There were 4 bidders. The apparent low bidder was American West Construction for \$925,180.00. The pricing came in approximately \$200,000.00 higher than the Districts current funding. TST presented options eliminate portions of the improvements (See TST Memorandum) reduce costs. The Board reviewed the options and elected to go with Option 2 with a \$177,662.45 reduction in overall costs and engage American West Construction to perform the reduced scope.
- D. USDA Rural Development (RD) Status District Continues the application process.
- E. Radium Solutions -

No feasible solution at the current time. The District is actively working with Roxborough Metropolitan District and Dominion Water to consider renewable water.

F. Triangle Waterline – TST provided estimates for Waterline relocation. The Board reviewed and determined the costs too high at this time for current financial ability.

- G. Disbursements The Board reviewed the Check Detail report presented by Director Connet in the amount of \$26,755.34 which includes check numbers 2865 to 2881 Excluding Check number 2877, and a debit card transaction in the amount of \$82.00. Disbursements Approved Unanimously
- H. Financial Report Director Connet presented the financials prepared by Schiller and Company. Financials approved.
